Dear Carl

This week has been a significant week for many reasons, not least because this week I had an operation on my heart to get rid of some cells that sometimes make my heart rate go very fast. Waiting with great fear before the operation, I considered asking the hospital chaplain to come and pray with me, (relatives were not allowed to stay). I didn't need to, because in the event I was waiting with a Methodist Minister who was about to go home and a Methodist minister that had just come to collect him. They both prayed for me and I felt so reassured. It was also a great opportunity to give my testimony to another patient having the same procedure. This might on the surface of it, seem a small thing, but this was a huge thing for me and I felt God had gone before me and I wasn't alone! For that moment this lovely patient was my neighbour. No-one should ever underestimate the power of a prayer or the kindness of a few words, especially at some of the most difficult periods of our lives.

This week I want to remind us all that what we are doing takes time, and in most cases we do not see major results immediately. It is a lot of prayers and a lot of small actions that lead to change happening over a longer period of time. Jesus tells us that this is how the Kingdom of God comes to be in Mark 4:26-29.



What I am trying to say, is don't give up...your prayers are working, even when you can't always see the results and even if in our Human understanding, the changes are small. God does not see things the way we do!

Mark 4:26-29 **New King James Version (NKJV)**


The Parable of the Growing Seed

26 And He said, "The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, 27 and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how. 28 For the earth yields crops



by itself: first the blade, then the head, after that the full grain in the head. 29 But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come."


Here we share a testimony of someone who has seen a small but significant change on their street, since they have been praying:



"We have lived in our road for over 30 years. It is a big road, so you don't often get to know your neighbours. We have found that since focussing our efforts to pray for our road that we have found more opportunities to speak to our neighbours and our neighbours becoming more open towards us. For example, my husband keeps bumping into a neighbour who works for a local charity at the bus stop and is able to talk to her and make meaningful conversation. Our next door neighbours know that we are Christians and make it clear that they don't talk about religion or politics, but recently someone in their family suffered from a significant illness and we were able to offer support. We have recently found out that another neighbour's husband died. Before we started praying we simply did not have this opportunity. Before, even if someone said hello it was unusual. We have been given other opportunities to offer support to neighbours and feel that it is God creating this opportunity".




I think we expect people to come to us in church, but I think we need to go into the community to meet them.



There feels like a big battle where we live, we know more people are praying than are recorded on the [neighbourhood prayer map](#), but still there does not appear to be that many people praying. We feel that as people pray the found becomes softer, we need more people to pray.

Invite others to pray for their street

We are approaching 1% of streets in the UK being covered in prayer, that we know about. We recently discovered that the people praying for their streets come from over 500 churches across the UK. We have 2245 streets signed up, to reach 1% we need 2600. We know there are a lot more people praying than are represented on our map. We will use the map in the future to target areas where there is not as much prayer taking place, and as a way of ensuring we reach our goal.

We are believing that as we cover every street with prayer over the next ten years, that we will see 1 million



new Christians as a result, with loneliness massively reduced!

Please help us reach our goal, spread the word, promote the book, encourage your Christian friends to pray for their own street.

We attach here our new [sign up sheet](#), you can return this to us by post (please make a photocopy) or by email. We do not record the names of anyone praying or their house numbers on our website, just the street name. We need people's email address' so we can send them this newsletter. If we can all get three people in our churches to sign up we would see 6000+ churches being prayed for... imagine the difference that would make.

We are asking people to pray for three houses on their street and a prayer of general blessing as often as you can over the street.

Word for Today and Father's Love Letter Distribution Over Lent




