
Highlights from The Year



Looking back over the year, I am surprised how much has happened and all of it has been down to people like me and you praying for your neighbours.

<u>Father's Love Letter:</u> 102,000 Father's Love Letters were ordered over the Lent period to be delivered to people's neighbours. We have heard multiple testimonies of people coming to faith as a result and people returning to church after many years of being away!

Others have given testimony of how in their difficult times, this has opened up opportunities to share their faith with neighbours.

There has recently been a steady increase in people reporting that one and twos on their streets are starting to come to church or becoming interested in the Christian faith. This is truly wonderful and is happening because people are praying!

This year we have heard testimonies of a man who was found on the floor, having had a stroke, getting timely medical attention because someone had heard from God that their neighbour was on the floor.

We have heard stories of people's cancer improving after prayer and other illness' being healed!

Testimonies of churches Working together in Unity

A major highlight was attending the "Saints in the Stadium" Prayer event in Saint Helens where 2000 people gathered to pray, October 12th.

We have heard how 28 churches in Folkestone have been working together to give out Father's Love Letters and Pray for their neighbours.

Loving Telford, Pray for Rugby and many other groups are working together in unity to pray for their communities and we will be sharing more developments of this in the coming year.


There is a sense of synergy as we have formed partnerships with other organisations, as we are all one small piece of the wider jigsaw of what God is doing.
