Tickets £4 plus booking fee, starts 7pm at Manchester Apollo, Stockport Rd, Ardwick Green, Manchester, M12 6AP

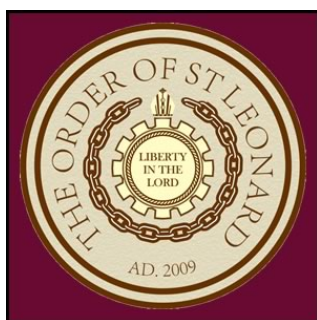

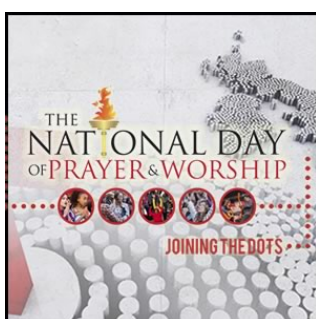
