In both instances we were forwarded a long list of streets by a church and postcode co-ordinator, which we manually added to the website. We have now reached over 1700 streets. Over the next few weeks, while the weather is sunny, we will be encouraging people who are able, to prayer walk their streets. We will provide prayer resources for this, next week. If all of us prayer walk our streets, we will be praying for over 400,000 people in the UK! Thank you to all of you for your commitment to pray for your neighbours!

group or church, as part of this year of mission. Please visit their website for more information.

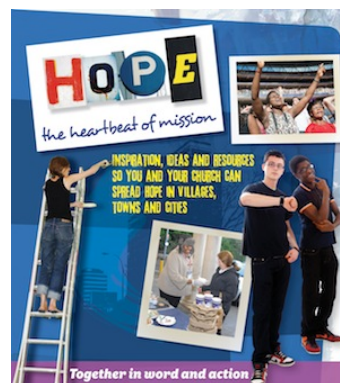

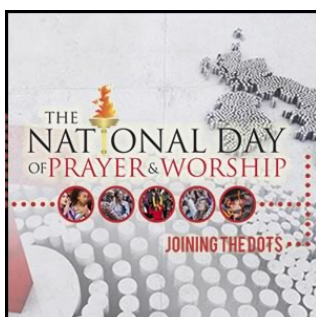
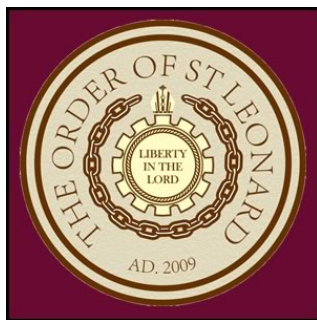
HOPE provides resources, training and ideas in a rhythm of mission around the church calendar.

SHARE

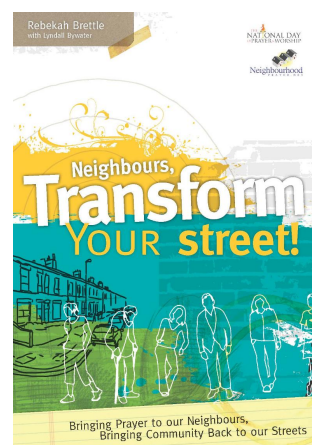
