

Last summer I watched someone using a huge blowtorch to destroy the weeds on his driveway. I have to admit I thought






**Big Lunch**

The age range was 6 months to people in their sixties, with people from very different backgrounds coming together, in many cases for the first time! Margaret has regularly organised street parties over the last few years, so her neighbours were used to invites. She served bacon butties, hot croissants, fruit, tea and coffee and mmore. The event lasted 2 and a half hours, most people were only invited two weeks before. A neighbour helped her prepare food and people who had never met, started to get to know one another for the first time!*
