

**Adding Multiple Streets**

If you do not have the postcodes we will look them up for you, but it will help us a great deal if you could provide these for us. If members of your church want to receive this newsletter with our weekly prayer suggestions, directly, we will also need their email address. Otherwise, we rely on church co-ordinators printing the newsletter and distributing in their local church.

Praise God ! There are more than 1500 streets registered on our map. Our mapping facility is now shared across several websites and after a few glitches, is running more smoothly. **Prayer Triplets**


It is our hope that many of you will form a prayer triplet,


#### Testimony (1)
