
Dear Carl,






Our vision is that "every street is prayed for" and that God will show us how to be good neighbours. Our prayer is that the streets of Telford and Wrekin will be safe and

9th May, Ascension Day we are starting prayer in a police station as this also coincides with the national day of prayer for the police. In the evening we are encouraging prayer walking with key landmarks in the borough being claimed for Christ. The Fire Brigade have given us details of streets where deliberate fires have taken place.

Friday night 17th May is a special evening for young adults called Taste and See... which will be at Whispers nightclub.. for worship, dancing and chilling with friends and in the Lord. Do please pray that many prodigals will come.
