
Gather


Thank you

Also, I ordered a 100 copies of Heavenly Father's love letter and keep one in my handbag in case I get an opportunity to give it away.

In Sainsbury's the other day as I was being helped by the cashier I heard the words 'You are loved' in my head. I baulked at saying it and just said 'God bless you' but then I thought, no, that was not what God said so I plucked up courage and decided to wait until she had finished serving the next family in the queue. I delved into my handbag and got out the card and after she had finished she noticed I was still standing there and asked if there was anything wrong. I said, 'No, but I believe God wanted you to know you are loved'. I handed her the card and told her it was a love letter from her heavenly father. She really thanked me, twice in fact and the mother said something nice about it too.
