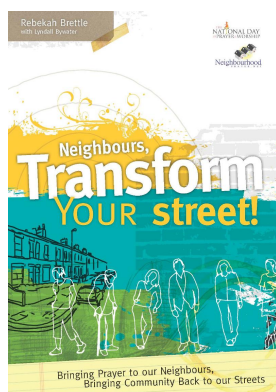

One thousand streets have been registered for prayer!

As we reached this milestone, I could not help but think that the only number that matters is one. One person, praying, week after week, maybe even year after year, believing that on their one street, prayer can make a difference.

There are approximately 260,000 streets in the UK, and our aim is to see Christians taking responsibility for each street in prayer. PRAYER

Isaiah 40:30-31
