

Dear Carl,

I love Christmas, the decorations, the tree, the time when we tend to see more of friends and family. As I walk around the shopping centre buying gifts, I can't help thinking that every year that goes by, the central meaning of Christmas seems further and further away. Apart from hearing the Salvation Army band playing Christmas Carols, there seems little or no mention of Jesus in our wider society.

As I sit as a GP, I hear of the worry people have of buying presents they cannot afford to buy, and for some, just how lonely this Christmas will make them feel. As Christians, let us not fall into the same trap and remember that the greatest gift we can give is our time. As someone who has in past faced the prospect of a or two Christmas alone, do not doubt the value of sending time with people and do not be afraid to share why you celebrate Christmas! The Christmas message is one of hope and not despair and some of our neighbours desperately need to hear a message of love and hope!

This last week, we met with Roy Crowne from <u>HOPE Together</u>, to see how he can contribute to the 2014 year of mission. Our discussions will continue in the New Year.

Never underestimate the power of your prayers or the time you invest in getting to know your neighbours.

Testimony

I wonder if our house is the only lighthouse of prayer in Duffield?

We prayed regularly for our road, Chapel Street, after Ed Silvoso visited Derby several years ago. However, it seems that in general the momentum in the Derby area stalled,



after some time, for various reasons.

About a year ago, we both attended an Ed Silvoso



conference at Watford, and then decided we would pray each day for everyone in our road by name - 17 houses. Also, I do extra praying a few times each week.

In this last year, we have seen over 50% of the street attend either a carol service, a potato supper, or a Big Lunch. For the latter we included 35 members of our Church - Emmanuel Community Church - which just happens to be situated at the end of Chapel Street (a culde-sac) - to make the numbers up to 70. "Unfortunately" it was cool and drizzly - no good for a street party for mainly older people - so we had to cram into the Church, which turned out to be just brilliant and a great occasion; one family who have recently moved in really excelled, and their older daughter is now attending Christian meetings in the week. Praise the Lord.

Now we've shown your bulletin to the only other Christian in the street, she says she wants to pray for the street with us once a month.

So it was easy for us to sign up for your network. Some half a dozen others also went to Wembley from Emmanuel - mainly non-Duffield residents. Perhaps some of them signed up for their roads, too.

God bless you in your good work !
