

Dear Carl,

Just in the last week we've added 57 streets in the UK being prayed for, which means we now have a total of 473 streets being prayed for in the UK. Did you know there are over 45,000 houses and over 110,000 people living on those streets.

Several people have come forward to represent their Church and to be postcode co-ordinators for their area. We are in the process of responding to these applications. [Please contact us](#) if God is leading you to this role.

I went to London on Tuesday to hear feedback about the "National Day of Prayer & Worship" at Wembley Stadium, on 29th September. It was a great meeting and we all agreed it was a wonderful day. We heard many testimonies of how lives had been transformed just by sitting in the prayer meeting! Prayer is powerful! We have had a number of encouraging testimonies this week. I have permission to share this one with you.

"Wow what an encouraging newsletter. As a family we held our first prayer meeting this Wednesday from 6-6.30pm. My husband, myself and our three children aged 17, 15 and 5, prayed for our community, our streets, the adults and the children, and that God will be known here and their lives transformed. We asked that where we live be an amazing testimony to the power of community transformation through Jesus. I felt God told me to get the bags of Hope which I did immediately afterwards, what a great confirmation to see your suggestion today to do the same..."

You might want to do a prayer walk of your street this next week and just pray a blessing over each house. If we all managed that we would pray a blessing over the 113,000 people living on the streets we are taking responsibility for - it's amazing what we can do together.
