A Testimony from the North of England

(anonymised to protect identities).

"When I moved into my road, I was the only Christian here and I started praying for my street. A couple then moved in here, they were also Christians. We started praying between us for our street. The drug dealer next door to me, left and a lovely lady moved in and she now has a young child. She looks after me when things get tough health-wise. The daughter of a local church leader who



*lived on my street was in a bad relationship and hated God. The relationship ended and she gave her life to Christ and is 'on fire' for God. The person living at Number * also now goes to the local Church. That leaves 20 houses to go! I just keep praying and things keep happening. My friends at the Prayer Room call me their prayer warrior because, although I don't get any public credit for what I do, I know that I am doing my Father's business."*

I spoke to the author of this testimony on the phone and I asked her some questions:



How did you know that a drug dealer was living next door to you?

"I was told by one of my neighbours, after I had just moved into my new house, I had been there only three weeks. I started praying and a year later they moved on. I did my best to show kindness to them, whenever I could."

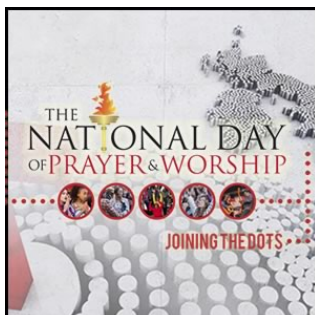
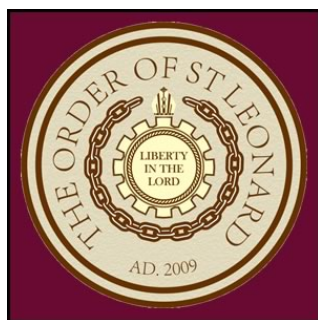
How long were you praying before other things started to happen?

"It was about five years. It is important not to expect miracles, because they won't come, not for a while. There has to be a change in people's heart first. You have to keep praying, even when you don't see answers to your prayers. Keep your prayers short and make sure that you are in relationship with God. It is God that does the work. It can be disheartening when you don't see anything happening, but you have to keep going, it doesn't happen over night, but over a long period of time."



What advice would you give to those who are praying for their streets?

"It is really important to get together with someone else. It doesn't mean that you pray together regularly, but when you can. My Christian neighbour and I met and drew a map of the street. We highlighted the houses on the street where we knew people and divided it between us. It is important to seek every opportunity to get to know people, keep what you know confidential and pray. For example, someone lost their job, so we prayed and they are now in a job that they love. I keep a board in my house with things on it that remind me to pray for people, cards neighbours have sent me and other visual reminders. I have some health issues, so I can't always do too much, but I can pray. I also think it is really important to carry a Bible with you wherever you are and use it. Also at every opportunity offer a short prayer to God. I pray very simply just as if God is standing next to me wherever I am - which He is."



The person I was speaking to, said that it was also really important to realise that this is all about God. Where things have changed it is because of what God has done,



and she didn't want any credit for the changes.

Lets all of us follow her example, and keep praying, wherever we are, even when the answers don't seem to come immediately, even for some years!

West Highland Way Bible Relay - The concept

- *As we walk the land to pray for Scotland and the opportunities the Games bring we will be passing a Bible from one parish to another down the West Highland Way and Kelvin Walkway from Fort William to the centre of Glasgow*
- *The Bible will be used by 'Flourish' during the games as they witness Christ in the heart of the city.*
- *There will be Penny Gospels per day to be given away to anyone who wishes one as the Bible travels down the West Highland Way and Kelvin Walkway.*
- *Where the Bible stops each night there would be a time of praise and prayer for the Games in Scotland.*
- *It is hoped that there will be some folk who will walk the whole way joined by individuals from each place it visits thus making it a team effort.*

What next?

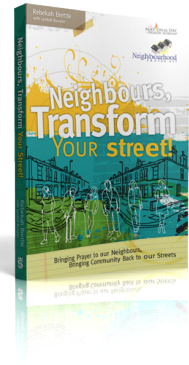
The idea is that each parish would be responsible for the passage of the Bible through their parish with the involvement of other denominations and the community within their area. This work is progressing well. The Scottish Bible Society
