Dear Carl

This week has been an interesting one on our street. Spurred on, by last weeks testimony, click here to view last weeks newsletter I have committed to prayer walking our street everyday. We have had some great conversations with neighbours this week and have also seen something that should not happen on any street in the UK, rival children gangs fighting each other (they were between 7-12 yrs old). In fact this even made us question whether we should live here, now we have Reuben. And yet, we felt God speak to us and tell us that we are living exactly where we should be, for such a time as this.



This weeks newsletter is for all people living on streets where it can be difficult and where there are not immediate answers to prayer. I firmly believe that we are all placed where we live for a reason. Here follows a testimony of someone who has lived in difficult circumstances for over 10 years and how through many years of faith and perseverance, they have seen some positive changes. More importantly I believe that this testimony shows that they have stopped things getting any worse. As children of God, (Romans 8), each of us lives with the authority of Jesus. We can all make a difference where we live, even when the results are not immediately obvious and even when it takes a long time for things to change.


We moved into this area over 10 years ago. Before we moved here, we didn't know the type of area that we were moving into, or the problems we would find here. It was however the place that God had reserved for us, and there













have been many confirmations of this over the years. We had prayed before moving that we would be exactly where God wanted us to be.

Not long after we moved in, the estate was the victim of savage council cuts, meaning that no ground maintenance took place: bushes over grew, rubbish piled up and one of the hedges became 30 foot high. Around that time, I read an article suggesting that the place people live in , influences their behavior. If you make somewhere a nice place to live, antisocial behavior and crime falls.

Shortly after moving to our house, the local vicar came to visit us, expecting to find the previous residents who were also Christians. He invited us to a conference where there were a lot of council workers. God instructed us to stand in one place and He would send people to speak to us. One of those people was a gentleman involved in regeneration. After speaking with us, he decided to visit the estate and helped to improve the area. God also told us that the hedge near us was a physical barometer of the Spiritual state of the estate. Gradually the physical state of estate improved. As a direct answer to prayer, a derelict site became a grow area for local neighbours. God told us it was a fertile place. Today beautiful flowers and vegetables grow there improving the appearance of the estate, giving pleasure to many. There has been no vandalism at this site.

A residents association was started and for a time, some other Christians joined us in prayer. We found favour with council groups and constituency groups. It took a long time for the council to realize that we wanted to work with them and alongside them. One of the challenges that we have found, is that the local churches and Christians have not always understood what we have been doing and we have at times felt isolated. We honestly believe that had we not moved here, prayed and followed God's direction that crime rates would have soared and this would have become a derelict area. There are sill major challenges.

We have got to know a number of people on the estate, but would not say that these are deep friendships. We believe that we have been "ploughing" for someone else to plant the seeds and reap a harvest.

Prayer Requests

Can you please join us in praying for this couple, for encouragement to keep going and for many to get behind what they are doing on this estate. We also want to pray for every area like this and for Christians across the country who are doing their best to see their area change for the better. Lets pray that all the people in these areas fulfill their potential, aspire to education, good jobs and that sickness and depression will reduce. We pray for workers to go into this area and areas like this and to co-labour, for a fruitful harvest.
